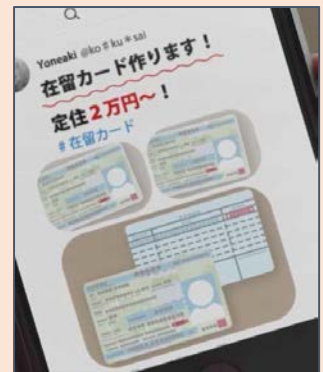
“Yami Baito” is a crime

What is “Yami Baito” (shady part time job)?

On social media platforms such as X, formerly known as Twitter, Facebook, or other online bulletin boards, criminal groups offer “Yami Baito” with tempting wording.



Tempting wording? “Well-paying”, “Easy”, “Everyone does it”, “You just do some shopping”, “All you have to do is to receive a parcel”, “You just sign a mobile phone contract”, etc.



It is also illegal:

- To create fake residence cards.
- To buy/sell bank passbooks or ATM cards.
- To buy mobile phones to resell.

If you started a Yami Baito...

You would end up with collecting and withdrawing fraudulent money, or committing robbery. Even if you wanted to quit the job, you would be threatened to continue.



In addition, you would get arrested without exception. After the arrest, you would be jailed, deported or ordered to compensate victims.

※Criminal penalty
Fraud: 10-year jail term or less
Robbery: 5-year jail term or more



There is no such thing as “easy and well-paying part time jobs”. Stay away from tempting traps, and have a safe and sound life in Japan!
