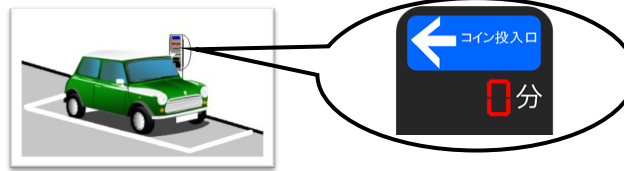

SINGLE-SPACE PARKING METER

1. PARK CORRECTLY IN THE LINED PARKING SPACE.

- * Before parking, be sure to check the indicator shows "○ MINUTE."
- * You can't park a big vehicle over two spaces.



2. BEFORE INSERTING COINS, CHECK WHETHER THE SENSOR HAS STARTED DETECTING THE PRESENCE OF YOUR VEHICLE.

- * Pay for parking in advance. You can't pay it later.
- * The meter accepts 100 yen coins only.



3. OBSERVE THE TIME LIMIT.

- * You can't keep parking over the time limit.
- * Parking over the time limit may result in **ILLEGAL PARKING**.



PAY AND DISPLAY TICKET MACHINE

1. PARK CORRECTLY IN THE LINED PARKING SPACE.

- * You can't park a big vehicle over two spaces.



SAMPLE

2. PAY FOR PARKING AND RECEIVE A TICKET AT THE PAY AND DISPLAY TICKET MACHINE ON THE SIDEWALK.

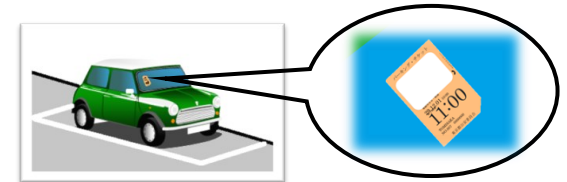
- * Pay for parking in advance. You can't pay it later.
- * The ticket partly includes a voucher for your payment.
- * The machine can accept a 1,000 yen bill or a 500 yen coin or 100 yen coins.



A ticket machine is located down below this signboard.

3. PLACE THE TICKET INSIDE YOUR VEHICLE ON THE WINDSHIELD SO THAT THE DETAILS CAN BE CHECKED BY PARKING ATTENDANTS.

- * If you fail to display a valid ticket on the vehicle, you may be subject to receiving a violation ticket for **ILLEGAL PARKING**.



4. OBSERVE THE TIME LIMIT.

- * You can't keep parking over the time limit.
- * Parking over the time limit may result in **ILLEGAL PARKING**.
